Parish Council Budget 2012/13 – have your say.

In 2011/12, for the fourth successive year, the Council felt able to maintain its budget at £18,674. The precept would also have been held at the 2010/11 figure of £15,778 but for the loss of the last of the former Chester City Council grants which were paid to offset part of the Council's expenditure. The grant of £645, roughly £1 per house, had been used towards the cost of litter picking. The precept for the year was therefore set at £16,423, equivalent to 49p per week for an average band D property.

The Council will meet in January to decide the budget for 2012/13 and welcomes views. Please contact any of the councillors or the Clerk listed in p4 or attend the informal drop in event advertised at the end of this article.

Superfast broadband

Delivering superfast broadband is a priority for Cheshire West & Chester, Cheshire East and Warrington Borough Councils. There are significant benefits for organisations and businesses that operate in the parish.

The three councils have formed the Connecting Cheshire partnership aiming to deliver superfast broadband to every resident and business by 2015. The partnership has recently secured £3.24m to start the process and needs local communities such as Guilden Sutton to help it demonstrate;
