Those using the Marigold room will find that an additional washroom/toilet has been installed. Security fencing was also constructed around the garden area last year.

Together with the kitchen, this all creates a pleasant, safe, self-contained area designed with young children in mind. The area is used extensively by the Preschool during term time but is available for hire for parties, meetings and activities outside normal school hours.

Fox Meadow News

After a good summer display the meadow was cut and cleared of hay in late July and August. This was done in several stages, not only because of the heat but also because it allows wildlife to move to the uncut areas. Thanks to those who helped with this, including the unknown person who cut the last section!



If conditions are suitable we will mow the meadow during the early autumn to remove as much fallen vegetation as possible. If it is allowed to rot down the fertility of the land will increase and that tends to favour grasses at the expense of the wildflowers.

During the winter the meadow will be very wet but in the spring the show will begin again without much human interference.

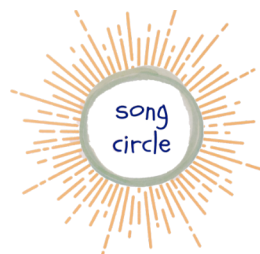

Hooks Wood is bouncing back after the extreme dry weather at the beginning of August (1st pic).



Thanks to recent rainfall, much of the greenery has recovered, while the trees have remained green throughout (below).



With autumn approaching and El Niño potentially bringing stormier weather, we'll be preparing the Wood for the months ahead. The ditches need clearing to ensure controlled surface water run off from the road by the Old School, through the Wood and its approach and into the drainage channels by the Green Lane byway pond.
