Modernising the constitution is well under way: a new draft has been produced and a temporary group of trustees appointed to manage the process. The election of permanent trustees and the ratification of the new constitution will take place at a general meeting for all Guilden Sutton residents to be held as soon as possible.

One or two special events are happening this month, including the Guilden Sutton 10K and Fun Run - only three weeks left to get fit for this event which is on Sunday, 18 September. The start is in Belle Vue Lane at 11am and finishes at the Village Hall. Details are on the website.

Hooks Wood

The trees are growing well, and a tidy-up is in progress for the Community Woodland day on Sunday, 25 September. This event for all the family will include a Forest School where children can learn about the trees and woodland in our area.

Wildflower Garden

The wildflower garden project at the end of Fox Cover is awaiting the next Parish Council meeting in September. Following the consultation meeting in July, proposals for the area will be considered, and the next stage in its development will be proposed. There is an Open Forum before the Parish Council meeting at 7pm on Wednesday, 7 September to consider the project. All are welcome.
